DIRECTIONS FROM NASHVILLE

Take I-65 South from Nashville (15 minutes from I-440)

To Exit #61 - RT 248 Goose Creek ByPass / Peytonsville Road

Turn Left and cross over I-65 and continue on Peytonsville Road for ¼ mile

Turn Left on Long Lane and Pass Ag/Expo Center---continue on around

Turn Left on Alfred Ladd Rd. at Entrance to "The Highlands at Ladd Park"

Continue down the hill make first left on Rich Road and immediate Right onto Wise Lane

Travel one block and make Right onto Clyde Circle - first house on right – 106
